What is a Chamber of Commerce?

A Chamber of Commerce is a form of business network whose goal is to further the interests of businesses. Any size business owners in towns & cities form these "local societies" to advocate on behalf of the business community.

"Members" elect a Board of Directors to set policy for the chamber. The Board hires a "President/CEO/Executive Director" and additional staff, if needed, to run the organization. Dues structure is set by individual chambers.

The first chambers of commerce were founded in 1599 in Europe. The world's oldest English-speaking chamber of commerce is in NY City, established in 1768.

Chambers do not operate in the same manner as the Better Business Bureau (BBB). Membership is strictly voluntary. Chambers represent the interests of businesses while the BBB represents the interests of the general public.

The chamber of commerce network is the largest business network globally. They are considered the "ambassadors" to the city and serve as a visitor or tourism center.
